Using software already on your computer, attendees will rework your own data to learn the secrets to becoming a dataviz rockstar.

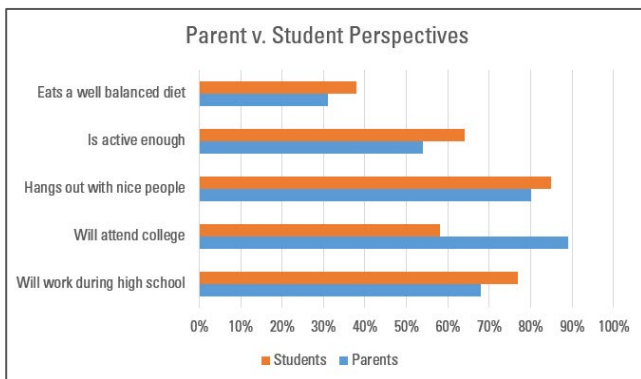

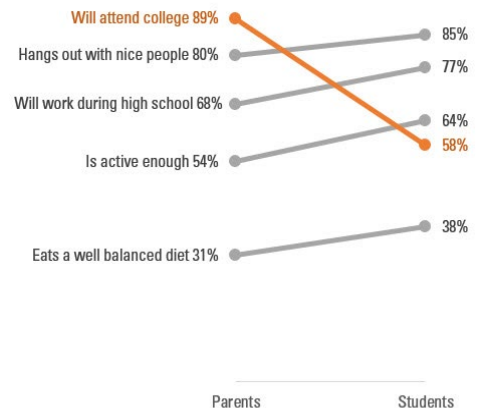
